Winter Break

The winter break will be from Saturday, 17th December 2022 through Sunday, 8th January 2023, and school will reopen from Monday, 9th January 2023.

Boarders

Boarders will be allowed to leave on Friday, 16th December 2022, after school and school will close for all students at 12 noon.

Boarders are required to return on Sunday, 8th January 2023, after the winter break, since school reopens from Monday, 9th January 2023.

Parents are reminded that Monday, 10th January 2023 is the last date for payment of fees for the last quarter (January to March 2023).

Parents are requested to complete all payments before the academic year ends so that your child's movement to the next higher grade is done seamlessly and his / her name appears on the new class list accordingly.

2nd Unit Test & Preliminary Examinations

The 2nd Unit Test dates and syllabus has already been shared with the students by the teachers and the same start from Monday, 9th January 2023 for Grades 5 to 9 and 11.

The Preliminary Examinations for Grades 10 & 12 also begin from Monday, 9th January

2023.

The Grade 12 Preliminary Examinations have been scheduled from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm to acclimatize / familiarize students to the Board Examination timings.

It is compulsory for students of Grades 10 & 12 to appear for the **Preliminary Examinations Please note there will be no retest conducted.** Students missing the Unit Tests will be marked as "absent".

Board Examinations

The **Board Examination Time Table** for the Grade 10 and Grade 12 students is available on the school website.

Students appearing for the Board Examinations must ensure that all fees till March 2023 (for Grade 10 ICSE), including the Examination Fees and till April 2023 (for Grade 12 ISC) are cleared before the Hall Tickets are issued to them.

Admissions

Admissions are open, particularly for the **Pre-Primary Classes** (Play School, Nursery & Preparatory) and a few seats are available across the school. **Siblings** will be given first preference for admission into the school.

Withdrawals

Any withdrawal of students after the Open House dates of the section will automatically entail **one month's notice fee** and parents have got to respect and understand that this will not be negotiable.

Book Sales

Parents are hereby informed that **Maharashtra Book Depot** (9850492518), Devlali, will continue as the school book sales supplier (for the Academic Year 2022-2023) for reasons of convenience.

Exchange Programs
