- Grades 1 to 4 are completing their 1st Term examinations and Report Cards can be collected on the day of the Open House:
 - Grades 1 & 2 on Thursday, 7th October 2021, from 8:30 am to 10:00 am
 - Grades 3 & 4 on Friday, 8th October 2021, from 8:30 am to 10:00 am
- Reporting time for students on the days of examinations 8:15 am
- Students will be permitted to leave by 12:40 pm, since 03 revision classes will be conducted once the examinations get over at 10:15 am.
- The school Teaching Staff may leave by 1:00 pm on the days of examinations.

Students of Grades 5 to 12 whose fees are cleared till the 2nd Quarter (up to September) will receive their Hall Tickets / permission for the Half Yearly Examinations. Students of Grades 1 to 4 whose fees are cleared till the 2nd Quarter (up to September) will receive their Report Cards.
