National Financial Literacy Assessment Test (NFLAT) for the academic year 2023-24

The National Centre for Financial Education (NCFE) is organising one of the largest FREE annual financial literacy tests for school students for the academic year 2023-24. The tests are organised annually to encourage school students to acquire the basic financial skills necessary to make informed and effective financial decisions in their future endeavours.

The test is open for school students from VI to XII in 3 separate categories as detailed below:

Categories	Classes	Language and Mode
NFLAT Junior	VI-VIII	English through Online (computer-based) mode
NFLAT Intermediate	IX and X	
NFLAT Senior	XI and XII	

The questions in the tests would cover the basic concepts of Banking, Securities Markets, Insurance and Pensions. Please note that this is only an assessment test, not any academic or competitive examination.

Registration and Enrolment Process:

Currently, registration is available only for the schools willing to conduct the Online Test (computer-based) on their premises. **Please note that direct registration by students is not allowed.** To participate in the test, the student must approach his/her school.

The registration and enrolment process involves the following 4 steps:

Step 1 School Registration	In the first step, the school needs to register itself for NFLAT 2023-24, and will receive a 'User ID' and 'Password'.
Step 2 Student Registration	Using the received 'User ID' and 'Password', the school needs to upload the details of students participating in the test.
Step 3 Student Enrolment	Schools are then required to enrol their students by selecting a 'Date and Time' of their choice from the available list on the page. Accordingly, each enrolled student will receive a specific 'User ID' and 'Password'.
Step 4 Take the Test	Once a student has been enrolled, the school must ensure that he/she appears for the test on the given dates using the given 'User ID' and 'Password'.
